

Tallinn Golf Cup by Sven Kaljuveer

1. DATE AND PLACE

August 28-30.2020 at 09:00, Estonian Golf & Country Club

2. FORMAT

The Championship shall be held in the following classes and playing formats:

Men

HCP plus – 9.4

Seniors

HCP pluss – 11.4

Men First League

HCP 9.5 – 18.5

With Seniors from

HCP 11.5

Men Second League

HCP 18.6 – 36

With Seniors

Ladies

HCP plus – 11.4

Senior Ladies

HCP pluss – 18.4

Ladies First League

HCP 11.5 – 26.4

With Senior Ladies from

HCP 18.5

Ladies Second League

HCP 26.5 – 36

With Senior Ladies

Players with handicaps bigger than 36 can participate with HCP 36.

A Senior or Senior Lady is a player who is 50 years old as at 1st of January 2020.

A player has the possibility to participate in either Men or Ladies class despite handicap or age restrictions of the class by letting the Championship Committee know during registration or before the start lists are published. Any request made later will be ignored and the player will be assigned to a class where he/she qualifies.

The Championship is open to all players. Professional players may only compete in Men or Ladies class.

The Championship will be held in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by R&A Rules Limited and Additional Local Rules approved by the Championship Committee and the Conditions herein.

Men, Ladies, Seniors and Senior Ladies classes will play 54 holes in stroke play. Men/Ladies First and Second League classes will play 18 holes in maximum score handicap stroke play and start on the final day of the championship.

Maximum Score is a new playing format where the maximum score for a hole is determined by the Committee. The maximum score for a hole in Tallinn Golf Cup by Sven Kaljuveer is net double bogey. The player gets a maximum score for a hole when he/she exceeds the allowed strokes or picks up the ball.

WAGR points will be awarded in Men and Ladies class.

3. FIELD RESTRICTIONS

The starting field will comprise of 144 competitors. If the number of entries exceeds 144, places in the starting field will be decided by the Committee based on handicap ballot.

4. WINNER AND PRIZES

The winners of the Championship shall be the Tallinn Golf Cup Champions for a period of one year. The Championship Trophy shall be held by hosting golf club, which will be responsible for the cost of engraving, insuring and maintaining the trophy and should return it, before the next Championship, to an address named by Marko Kaljuveer.

The winners shall receive a 1st place medal, the runner-up 2nd place medal and the third-placed competitor a 3rd place medal. All players from all classes will earn Estonian Golf Trophy points according to the following breakdown:

If there are 10 players or fewer in a class, the points will be totaled from the bottom up. For example: In a class with fewer than 10 four players, the last place finisher in the flight will receive 30 points, second to last will receive 40 points and so on up the schedule of points, with the flight winner earning a 25 point bonus.

5. DECISION OF TIES

In the event of a tie for the top 3 places in stroke play classes between two or more players, the winner shall be decided by sudden death play-off in stroke play. Play-off holes will be decided by the Committee before the playoff takes place. The play-off shall start as soon as practicable after the last competitors have finished their final round. The remaining ties shall be decided based on scores for the final 36, 18, 9, 6, 3, 1 holes. If the tie still exists, an 18-hole count-back will be used for the previous round. If there is still a tie, then the better score is decided by lot.

All ties in maximum score handicap stroke play will be decided by lower handicap. If this does not produce a winner the tie shall be decided based on scores of the final 9, 6, 3, 1 holes. If the tie still exists, the better score is decided by lot.
